Directions to Fairview Mennonite Church: Coming from the north on I-5, take exit 233 (US 20); turn right over I-5 to the first turn off to the right onto Spicer Drive. Follow Spicer Drive about one mile to Spicer Road. Left on Spicer Road about 2.7 miles to a "T" where Spicer Road continues by going left. Continue on Spicer Road for about another .4 mile to Goltra Road and to the church. From the south on I-5, exit at Route 34 towards Lebanon and go east to Goltra Road. Turn left on Goltra Road and continue to the church.
