THE MISHLER FAMILY HISTORY - Melva Lloyd

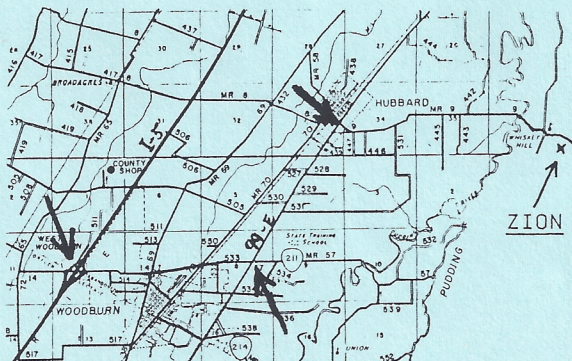
Melva lives at Sherwood, OR. She is the mother of
